New focus

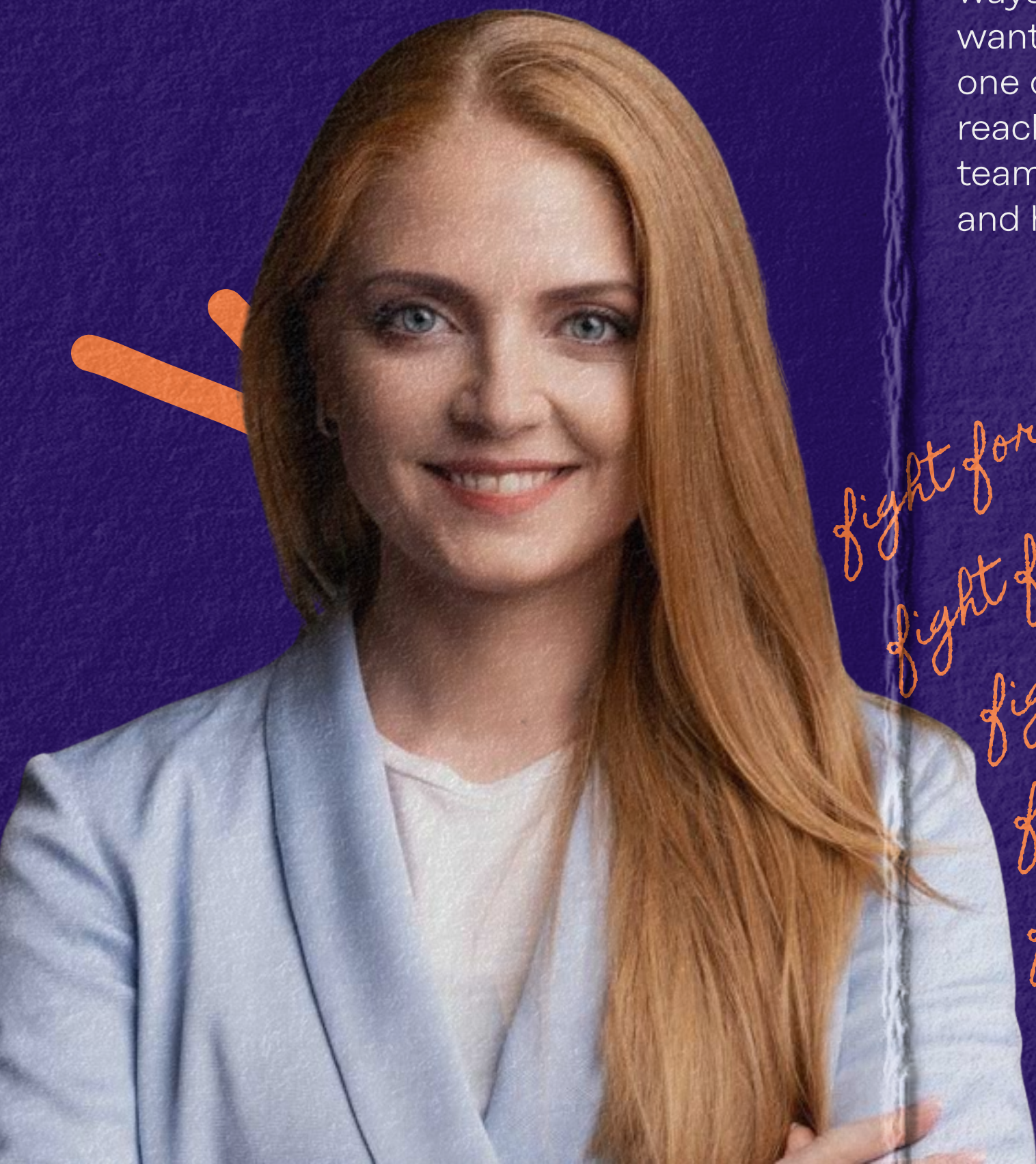
Talking with teenagers, students and teachers, we see our greatest challenge in the opportunities created - and not only for the younger generation but also for people of all ages. Partnerships for local action but global change

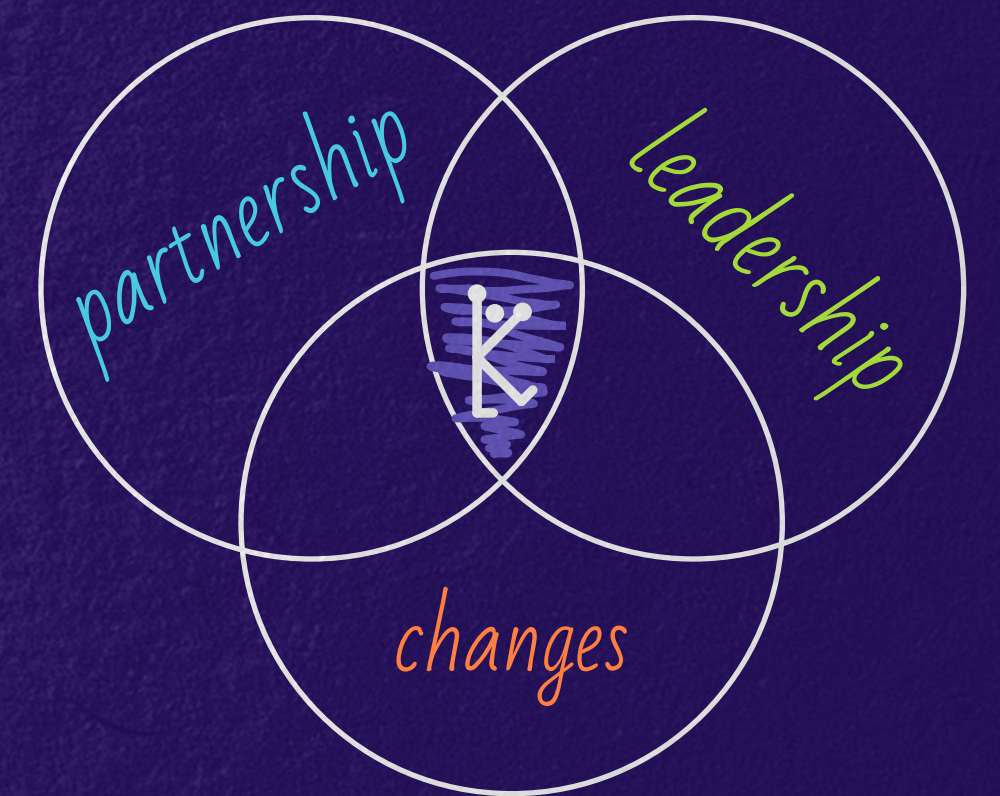

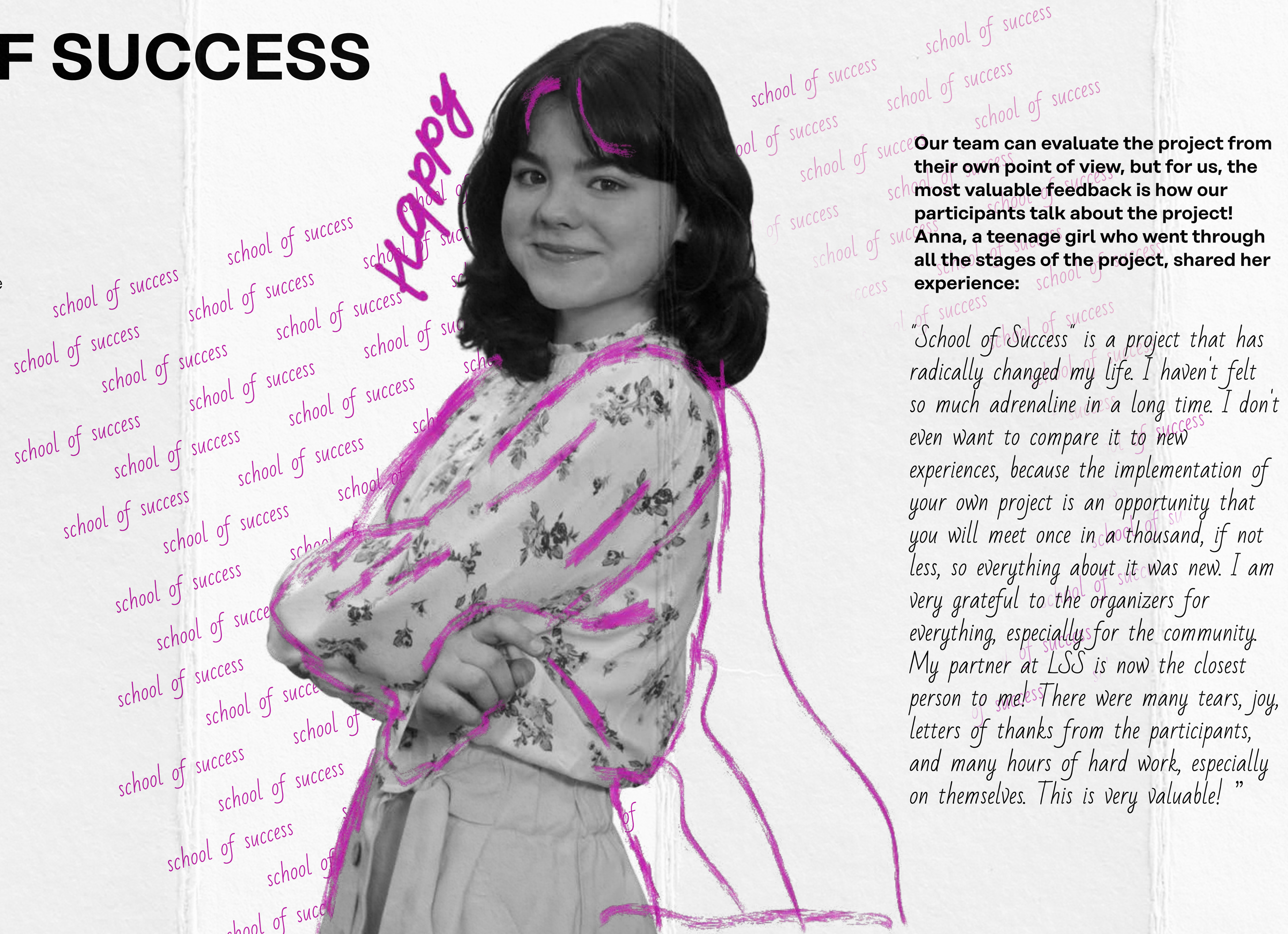


SCHOOL OF SUCCESS

"School of Success" is a project that reveals new facets in teenagers. We convey to each participant what we genuinely believe for them: "You can do anything!"

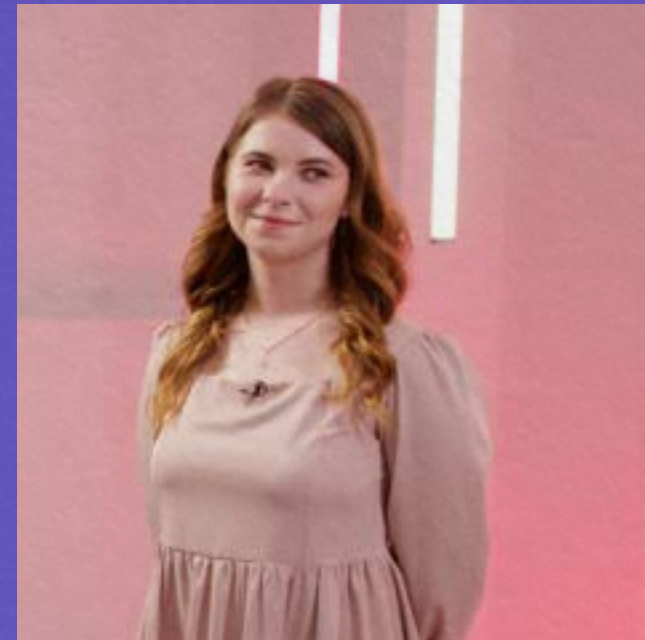
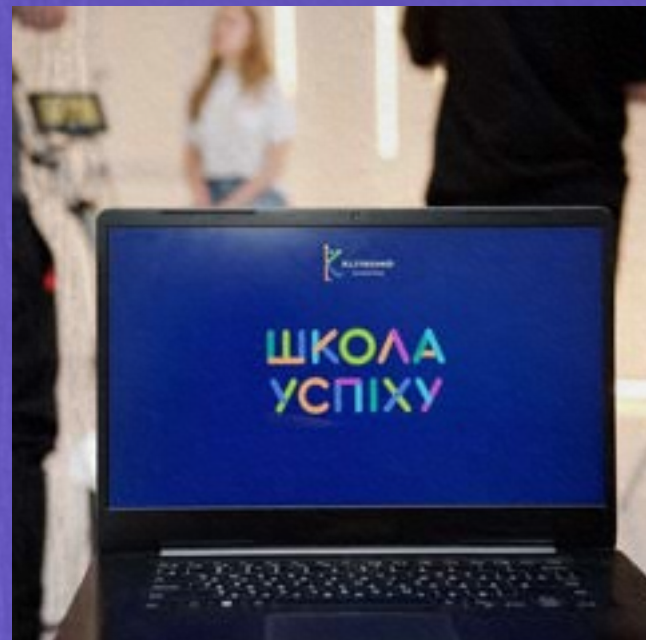
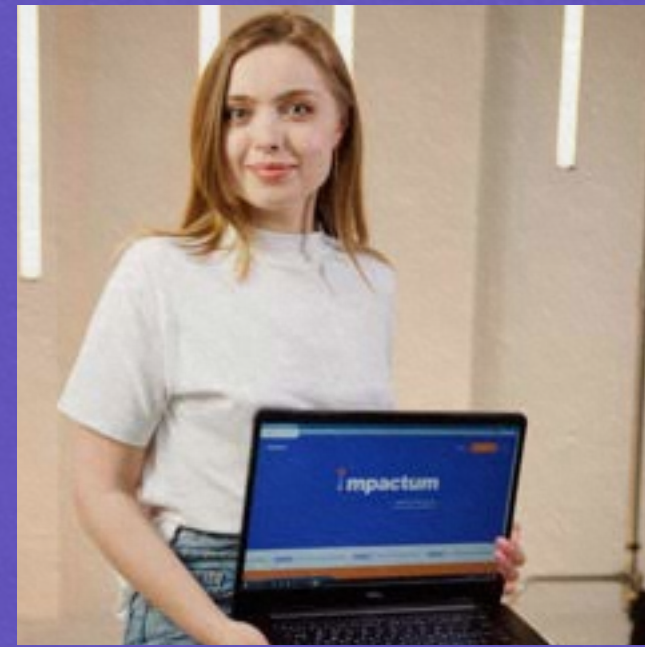
We talk about project management, sex education, career guidance, and communication and show that everyone sets their own limits and there are not all topics that teenagers can touch on.

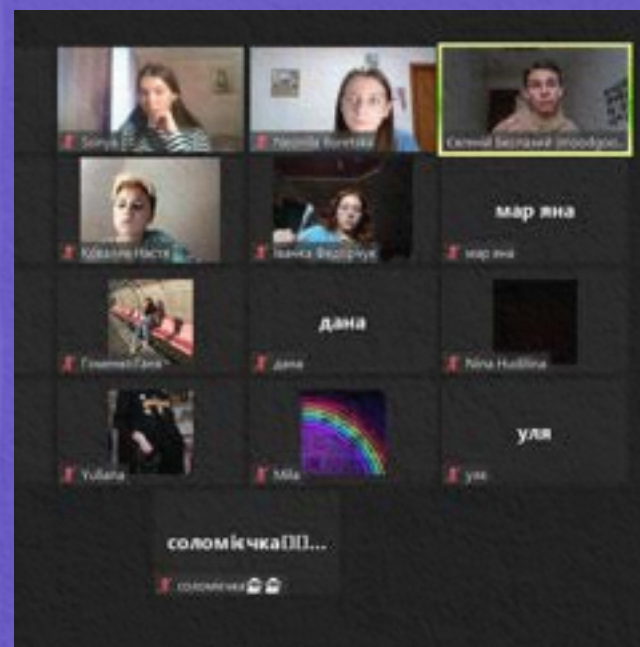
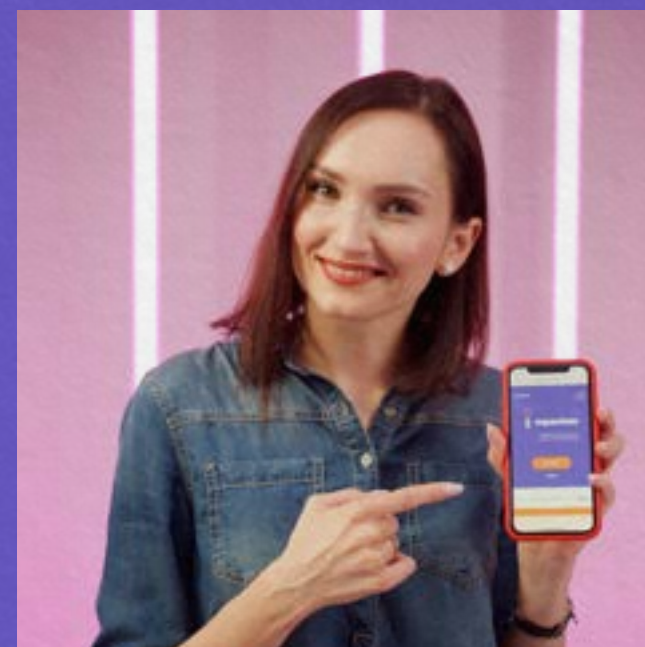

ZERO WASTE SCHOOL

This project is not about those who turn a blind eye to environmental issues, and certainly not about those who will idly sit by. It has been the 4th year of a project that brings teachers and students together in teams around one goal - to implement eco-change of different scales in their communities!

Zero Waste School is a lifestyle chosen by all participants in the program. And how nice to see that the community of change-makers is growing every year!

In 4 years, we have a total of 266 teams that have locally created an eco-community of over 100,000 people!

The project was implemented with the grant support of The Coca-Cola Foundation.



In 2021, our participants underwent digital training on the Impactum platform for a month. Tetyana Verbytska, a teacher, shared with us about her first steps in participating in the project:

“The project gave teachers and children of our institution the opportunity not to stop at what has been achieved in the environmental field so far. Go further, improve your knowledge and skills, pass on the experience to others, and, most importantly, do not be indifferent to problems. It was a unique experience for which I am very grateful! But we will not stop there and are now preparing to implement our own eco-project - because change starts with us!”

CHALLENGE ACADEMY

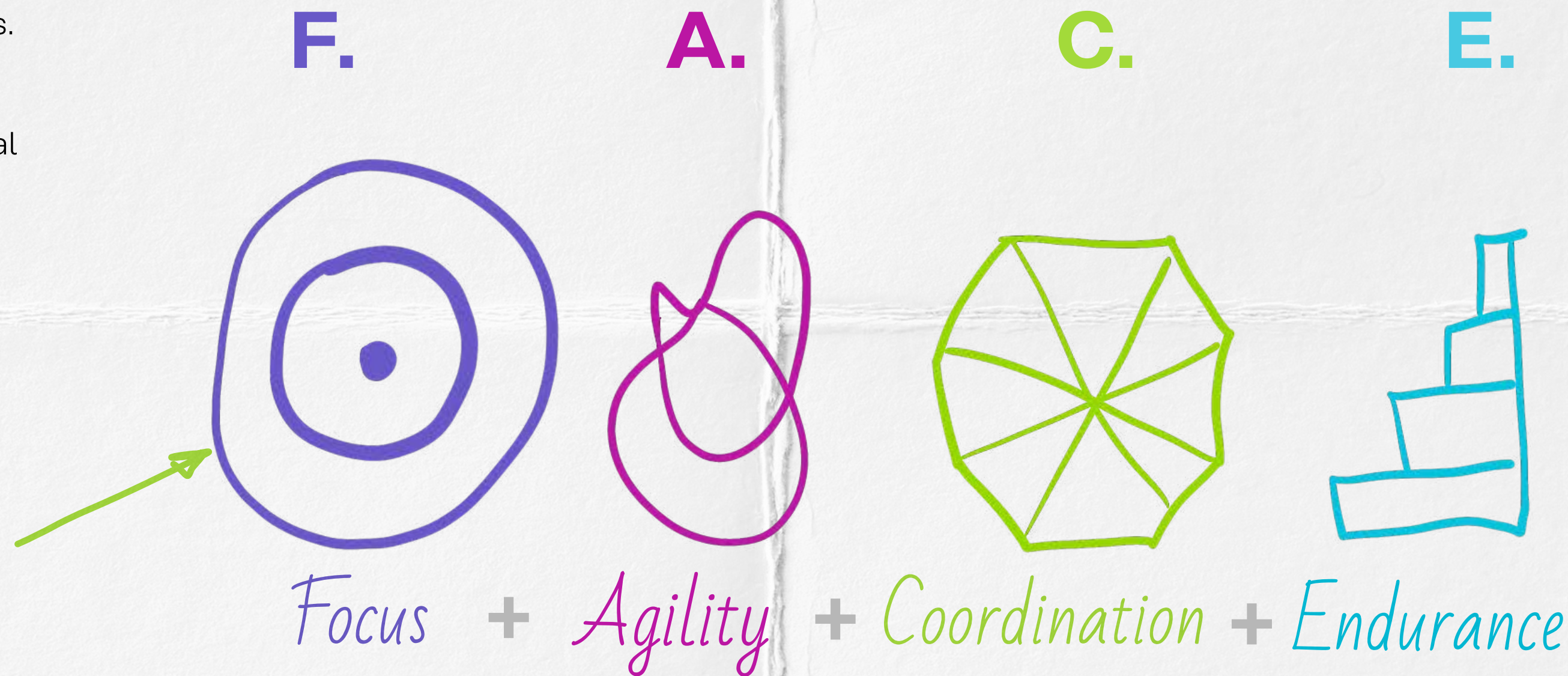
There are no problems in life, only challenges that each of us can choose to accept. Challenges of all kinds - from personal to global. This is precisely what teenagers from Ukraine and Germany have been exploring within the project for 2 years. Using the method of Wladimir Klitschko - "F.A.C.E. the Challenge" - participants learn to act in respect to challenges such as global warming and social equality.

This year we were able to create an environment of intercultural exchange, lots of motivation to implement our own projects, and an atmosphere of friendship and community within the online format. And it doesn't matter whether you are a teenager from Kyiv or Berlin - "F.A.C.E. the Challenge" is a method that everyone can use in practice!

The project was implemented in cooperation with DFB-Stiftung Egidius Braun and Klitschko Ventures, with grant support of the Erasmus+ program of the European Commission.

Anna, a participant in the project, told us more about how she managed to do it:



"Challenge Academy helped me look at achieving goals from a completely different angle. After the project I repeatedly used the method of "F.A.C.E. the Challenge" and even talked about it at my local "School of Success". Previously, I did not think about how important it is for us to understand the concepts of "success", "happiness", and "motivation". We discovered them in a new way during many discussions, so I learned to better analyze my attitude to certain aspects of my life. Now that much has passed since the end of the project, I still remember our discussions and sometimes understand some ideas in a completely different way, which is both surprising and gratifying. Challenge Academy is an astonishingly cool opportunity for young people to find out how to succeed!"

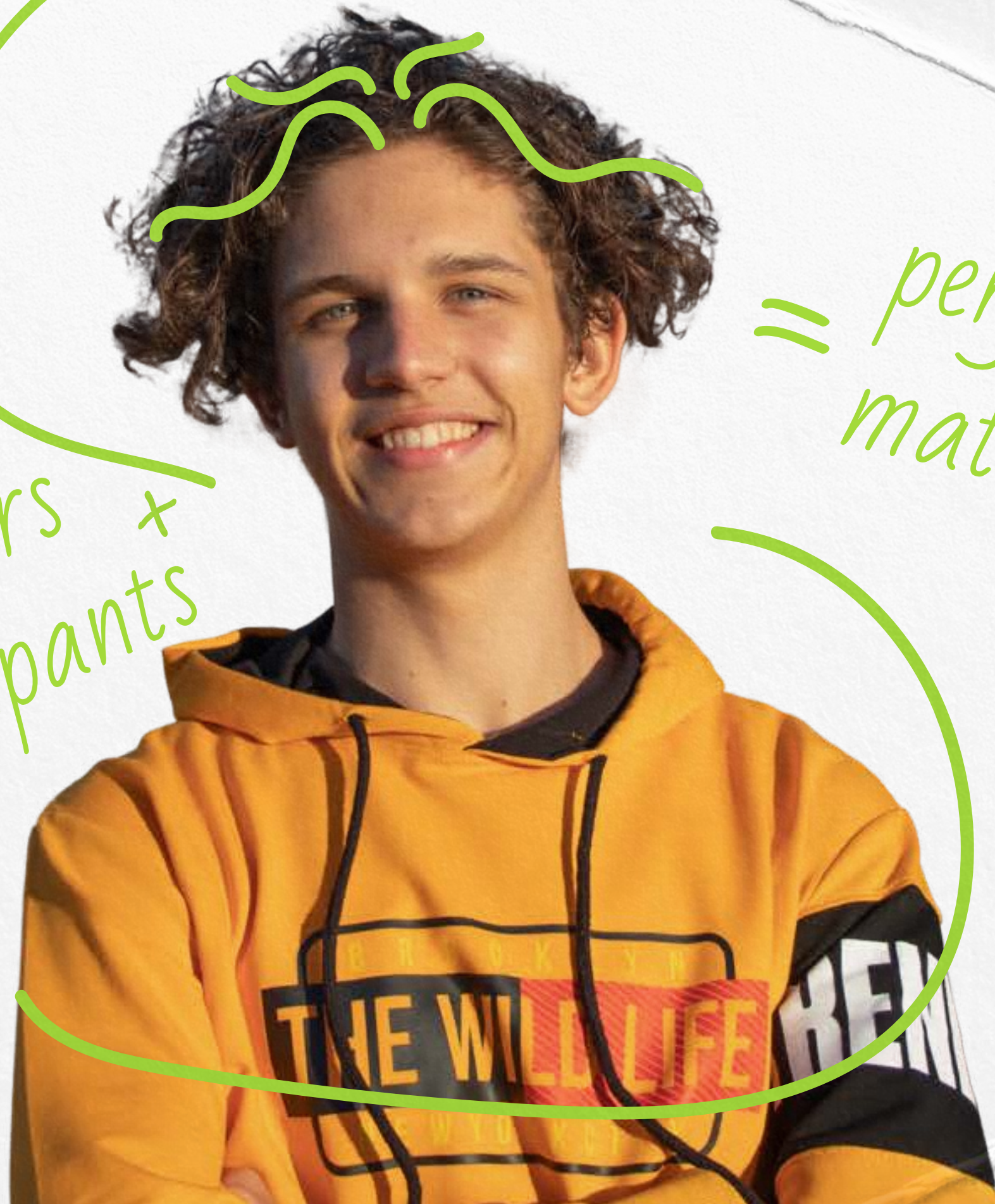
Trainings

The project was implemented in partnership with The Aspen Institute Kyiv. Yulia Tychkivska, director of The Aspen Institute Kyiv, says:

"Global development increases the importance of competencies related to critical and creative thinking, i.e. the ability to formulate effective solutions in atypical situations of increasing complexity. The generation of modern schoolchildren will reach social maturity when creative and critical thinking become a necessary condition not only for a decent life but also for social adaptation. Our joint project with the Klitschko Foundation "Realms of the future" gives teenagers the opportunity to develop these competencies, and is also a great opportunity to get to know oneself and one's life purpose."

We are always happy to see our graduates in other projects, as mentors, volunteers, interns, and sometimes as part of the foundation's team. And within this scope, we are continuously experimenting - implementing new projects, looking for new partnerships and supporting this community of like-minded people!

So what happened at KF-Hub in 2021? 4 initiatives have been implemented - "Dreamship", "Internship", "eleMentor" and "Synergy". Let us have a closer look at each of them.



DREAMSHIP

This is not the first time that the Klitschko Foundation has provided students with the opportunity to gain professional experience. Dreamship was created for Ukrainians studying abroad to showcase career opportunities in Ukraine, join the charity culture and share the foundation's experience. Ukrainian students studying in Lithuania, Latvia, Poland and Greece joined the project.

Our idea was to create an online internship that is genuinely effective - so that every intern can feel like an important and needed part of the team through laptop screens. That there would not only be real tasks from managers but also an exchange of experience, useful materials, and own cases. That it would be a space of creativity, for expressing their own ideas, and for receiving opportunities to implement them.

What do the participants say about the project? We asked Ulyana Kuziv, an intern in a project department.

"This is a cool project for the first internship. I gained skills in the field of project management and joined the implementation of the foundation's projects. We also attended interesting lectures on career development, communication, and even emotional burnout. The most memorable lecture was about writing a resume. During the class, Anna Mazur commented on the resumes of all interns and gave useful advice, so I knew exactly what I needed to fix. Now I feel ready to join the labor market because I have the necessary experience and skills."



INTERNSHIP

Our task was clear: To give young people the opportunity to experience all stages of employment, from an interview to recommendations for the first job, as well as receiving help make an informed choice for the future profession. Agreed, the task does not sound easy, but it was definitely vital to our team! For 7 years in a row, our team is open to students looking for their first working experience.

ELEMENTOR

What profession to choose? Which university to apply to? And where to look for experience? And how to make a choice and not be mistaken? These and thousands of other questions concern almost every teenager around the world. We in Ukraine gave our all to create that perfect "match" of adults and teenagers in order to answer all these questions. That's why the eleMentor project exists!

Our project mission is to create a movement of career guidance support for adolescents within Ukrainian society, who at their age usually find themselves at the crossroads of professions, on paths of obtaining education, and in search of their destination.

Our mentor Lydia said about participating in the project:

"I have a special attitude towards volunteering or charitable projects because this is my way of being involved in the development of the country. It seems to me that mentoring is a very cool way to rethink yourself, your values, and your true desires. It is an opportunity to get information about a profession that is not publicly available, and it is even more valuable because you learn from someone's experience. You can hear an external opinion on what you do not see yourself, or deliberately ignore. This is not the first project in which I am a mentor, but every time it is something very new and valuable."

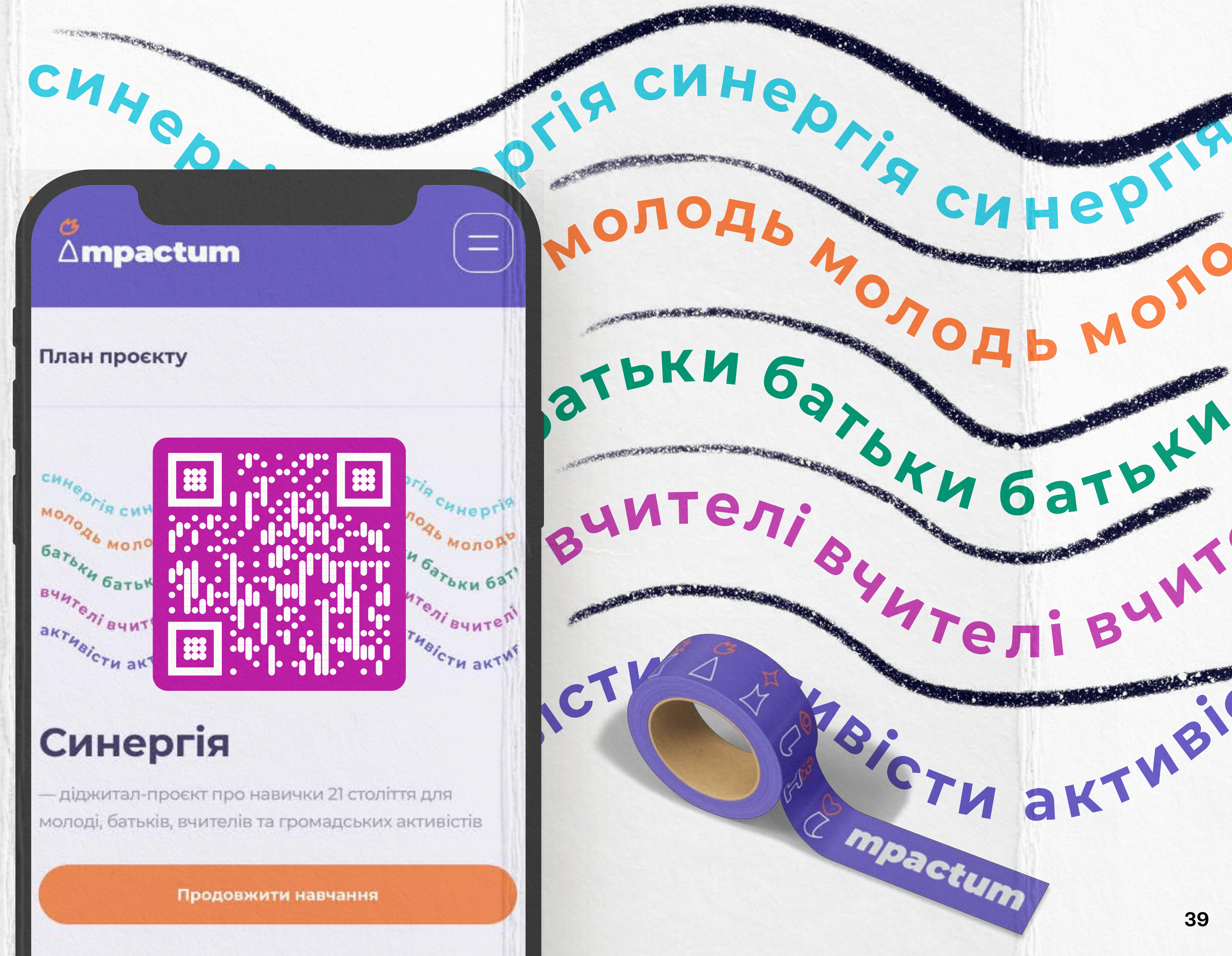

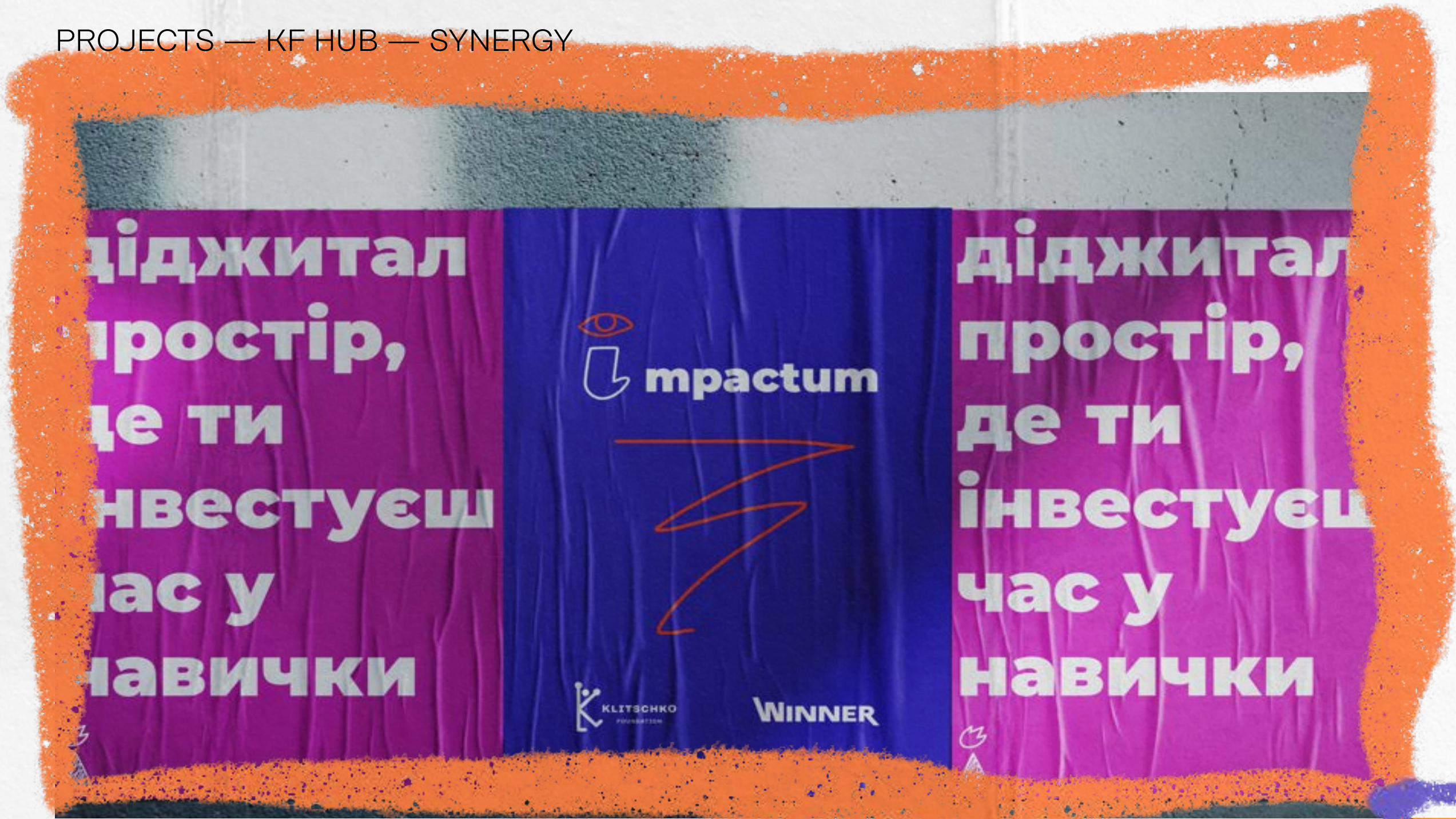
Higher mathematics, probability theory, Pareto law, non-molecular structure... it is incredible how many different phenomena, concepts, and ideas we study at school, or university. And what a pity it is that there is no institution where the necessary life skills are taught – how to talk to children or adults, how to present your ideas, how to manage your own money and how to deal with uncertainty. These are skills that are so needed by everyone in the 21st century - teenagers, and their parents, and teachers! We could talk for a long time about what a pity it is, indeed, such a pity... instead, we used that time to create a basic course!

This resulted in 17 modules on project management, creativity, media literacy, leadership, flexibility and many other relevant skills of the 21st century for young people, parents, teachers and employees of organizations.

The number of people trained has convinced us that we have created a really necessary project. It's over 3,000!

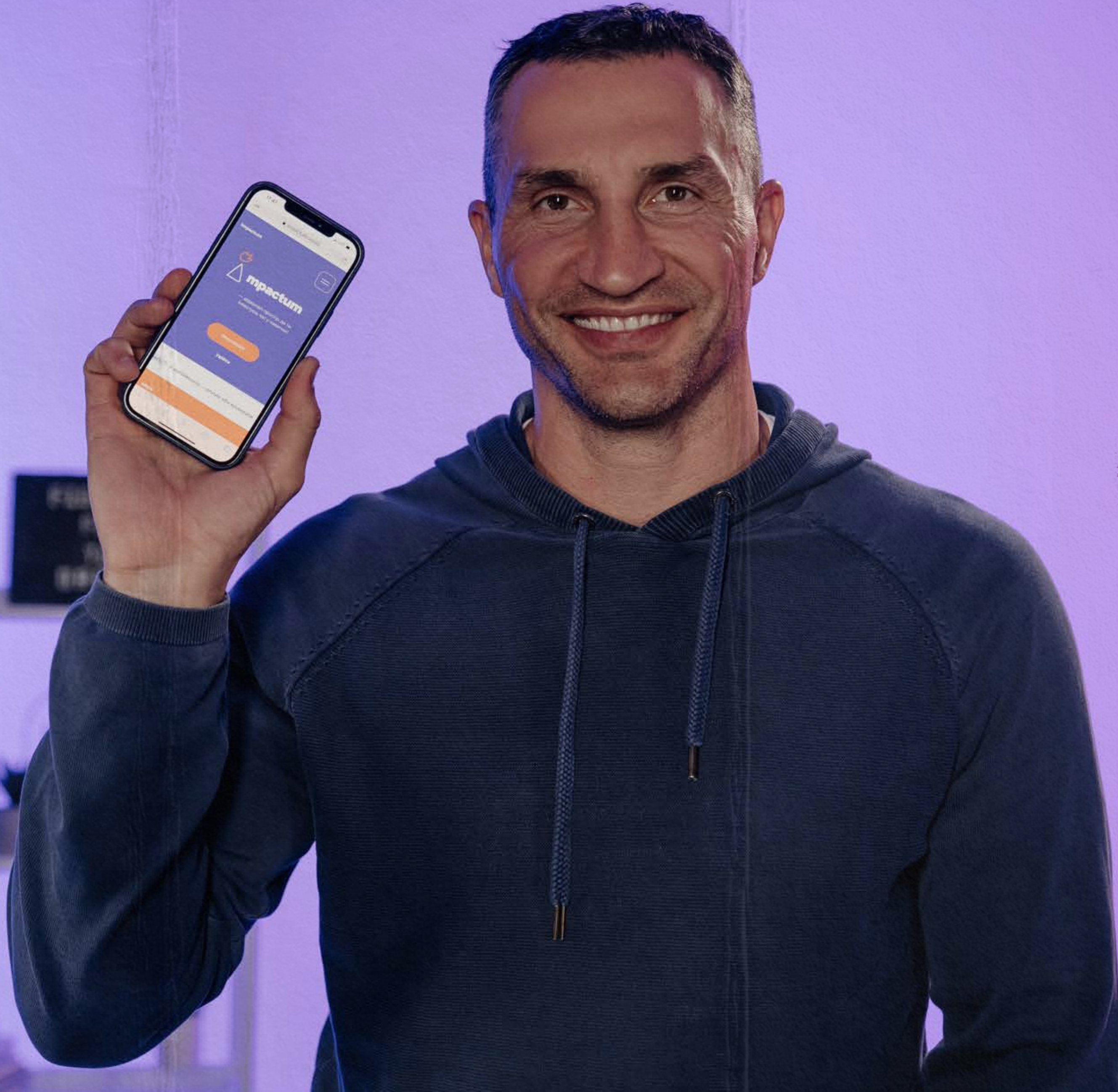

SUCCESS PACKAGE

This is a project with a long history. Over the years of the initiative, we have transformed the formats of sports development in schools and, finally, created our own formula:

New knowledge and experience of teachers + qualitative and safe equipment + effective changes in teaching = sports-motivated youth!

The formula worked this year too! We were very happy to see people in the project who, by their example, break the stereotype of teachers who are not interested in their work and prove that sport is an integral and extremely important part of everyone's life, both for children and adults.

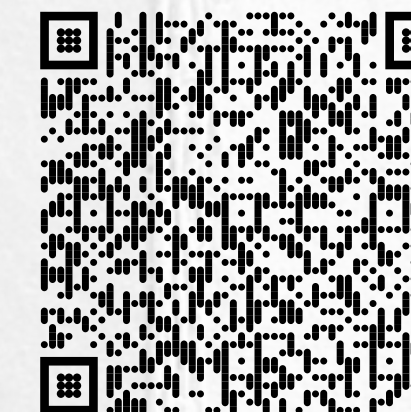

START TO SUCCESS

We often ask ourselves: why do young people choose video games instead of outside sports games? What is missing in society for children to have a soccer ball or a tennis racket in the first place, rather than a mobile phone? And we found a very simple answer. Where to play with this ball? Is it safe to do so in the old field near the school? In order to dispel all these questions and find answers, we have the Start to Success project in the fund every year.

The project aims to modernize sports equipment, financially support athletes in international competitions, provide transport for teams, update uniforms and hold master classes for outstanding athletes.

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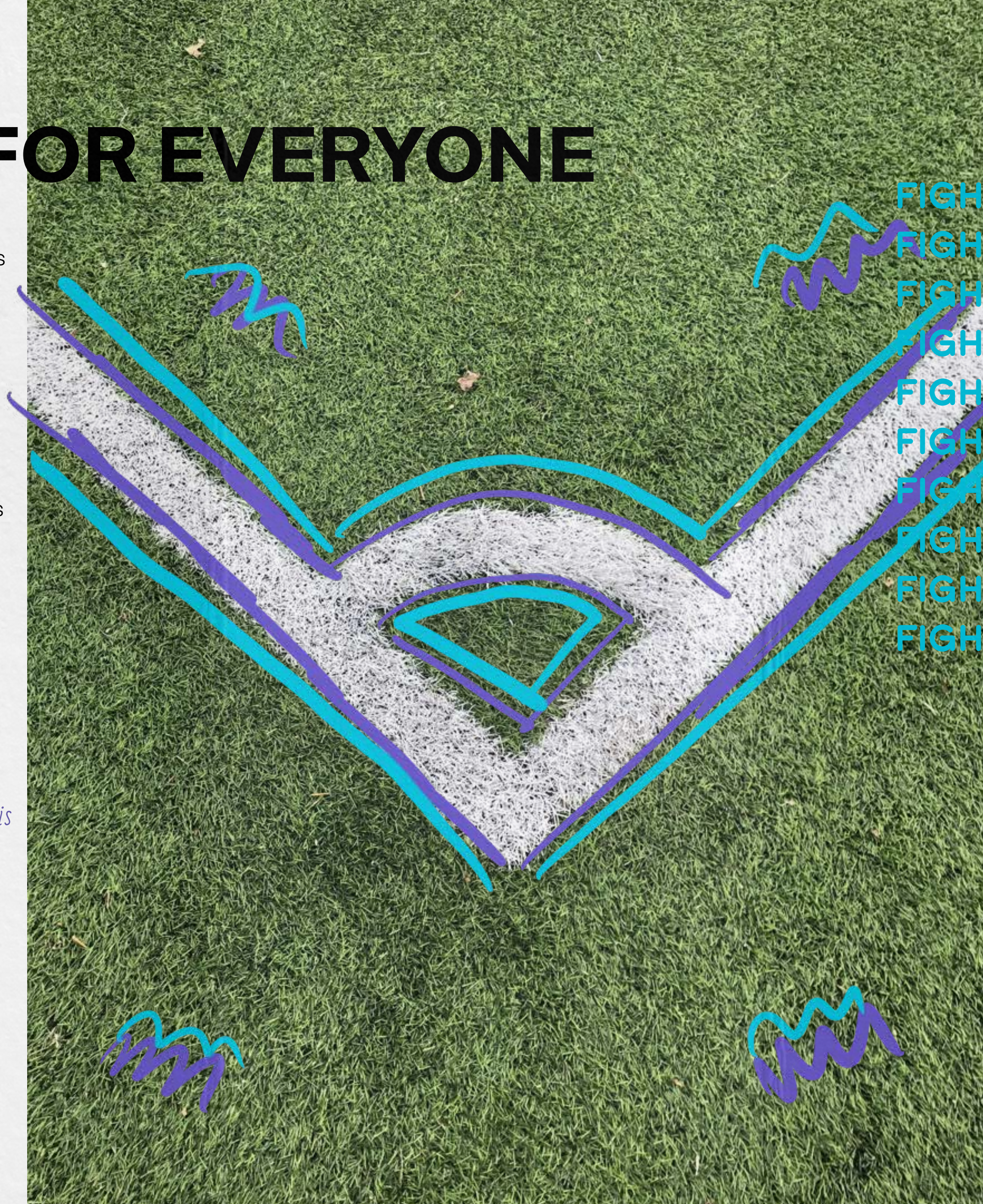
FOOTBALL FOR EVERYONE

Unfortunately, in the 21st century, stereotypes and discrimination against people in sports based on their gender or sexuality are quite common. In fact, in order to influence such negative phenomena in our society, we joined the Football v Homophobia Month of Action initiative and implemented the Football for Everyone project.

We have provided physical education teachers with a wide range of knowledge and skills so that they can create an environment in their schools in which every child will feel safe to play the sport they enjoy.

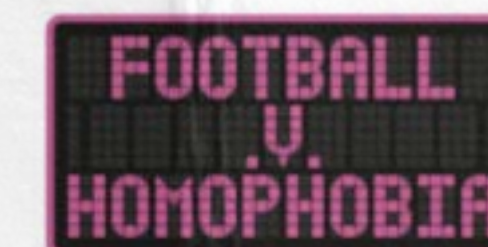
Alina Ivakhnenko, a participant in the project, says:

STUDY VISIT FOR GRASSROOTS TRAINERS

In Ukraine, there is no social mobility between sports clubs, physical education teachers, coaches and NGOs. The result is a significant difference between sports life in European countries and Ukraine. To create a network of professional acquaintances to share experience and knowledge, we created a project with partners.

The project was implemented in partnership with Towarzystwo Sportowe Iron Man, UKS Varsovia Warszawa, Fare Network, Fortuna Hjørring, The University of Management and Coaching in Wrocław, DFB-Stiftung Egidius Braun, ELDERLY and Hrvatski Nogometni Klub Gorica.

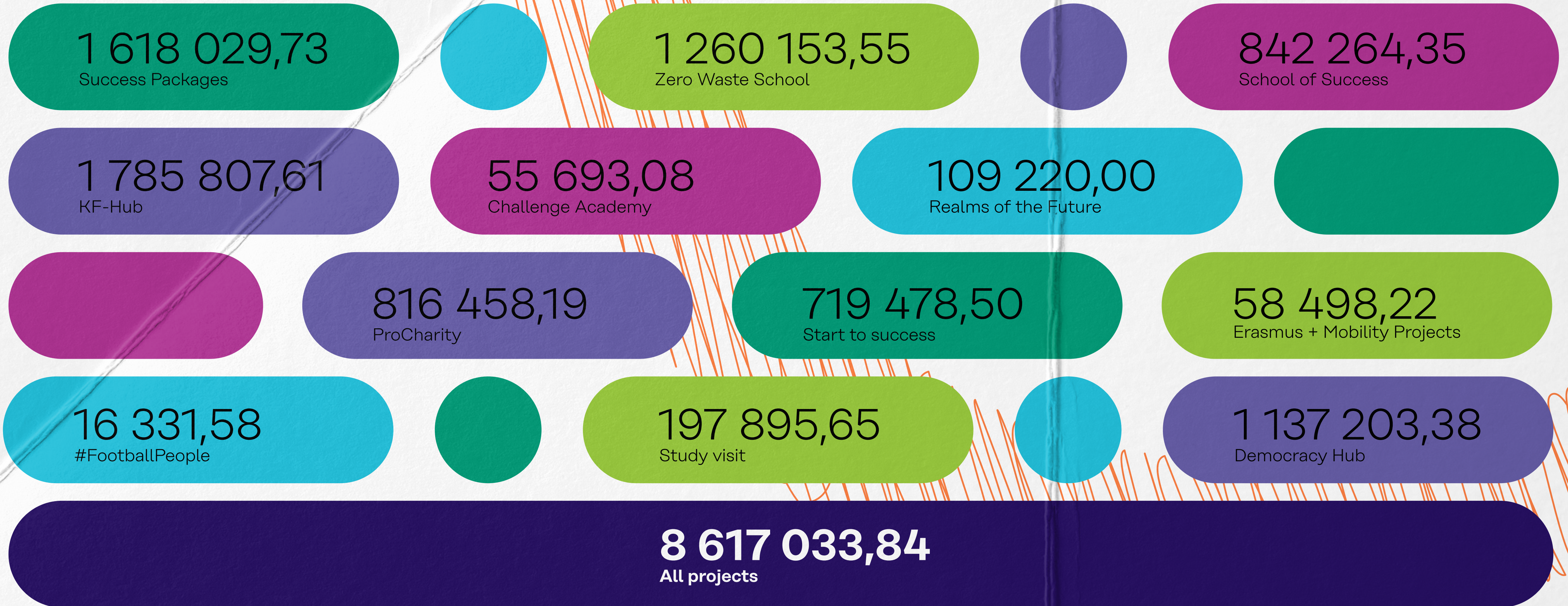

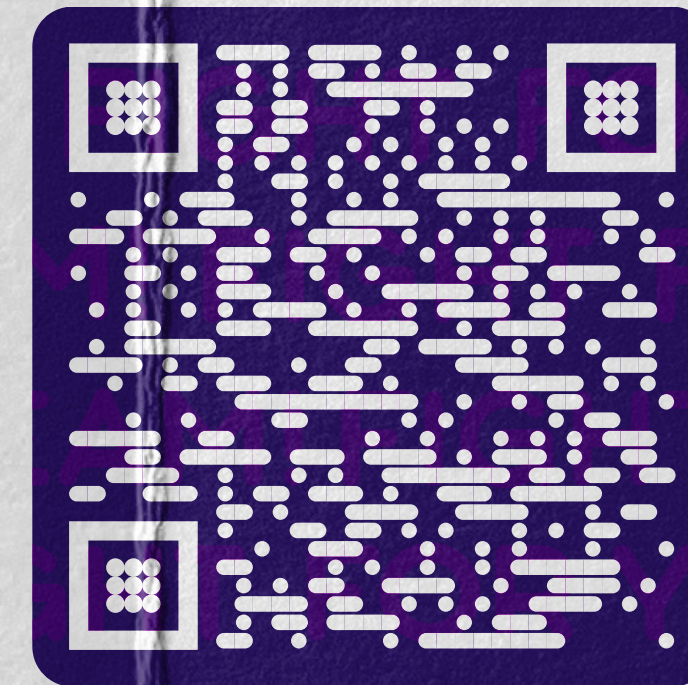
